- The Council Burial ground is open for business, sign ready to go up, terms and conditions for use yet to be determined.
- New Contractor in place for Llandyssil Play Area Inspections and emptying bins, our gratitude to Cllr. Williams for maintaining the service in the interim.
- Dolafon Trust had just applied for planning permission for the Gospel Hall and 4 dwellings, this development delayed, awaiting Network rail permission for foot path.
- Powys County Council had announced plans to develop a processing plant for recycling on the Abermule Business Park , the promised site visit to the recycling plant at Rhayader has not materialised, we trust this can be arranged before any pre-planning consultation.
- Abermule School Play Area, new equipment installed, awaiting new lease to carry out works to the area.
