A Message from County Cllr Gareth Pugh elected member for the Dolforwyn Ward.

So far this year we've experienced more wintery weather conditions than normal. Powys Highways worked extremely hard keeping the roads open during the bad weather and have received much praise for their efforts. Locally I felt they could have responded quicker on our C roads which lead to the heavier, populated areas. A number of residents have brought this point up with me.

Also, it came to light (a little too late) that if you need salt piles leaving on the side of the road, there is a new policy which means you can request this by calling 01597 827465 or 0845 6027035. I suggest you do this before the next bout of bad weather, so that you are prepared.

It was also noted that in the snow a few residents of Abermule chose to park their cars on the main road outside of Abermule stores for a prolonged period. This caused delivery problems and difficulties accessing the store for the disabled and elderly. Your consideration next time would be much appreciated in keeping this area clear.

Flooding on the Abermule to Llandyssil road still seems to be a problem, I have reported this issue to PCC.

Powys has identified two new clients likely to go ahead with developing their automotive businesses on the Abermule Business Park along with plans for the recycling centre to be sited at the far end of the site nearest Newtown. However, all of this is subject to Planning before commencement.

Powys CC have purchased Unit 4 on the Dyffryn estate. Their intention is to clear the building and transform this unit into the new waste and recycling centre for Newtown.

Thursday saw a vote to scrap the three Shires Committees. I found these meetings very helpful when discussing local issues and regret that the vote to stop these committees was carried by 34 votes to 22 as part of ongoing cost cutting measures.

A quick reminder to people that if their boundary joins a pavement or grass verge, it is their responsibility to cut and look after both sides of the hedge or fence and not Powys CC.


