

Update from your County Councillor

- **1. Closure of B4368 (Abermule to Hodley)** The 'dingle road' as it is locally known, will close on September 5th for 4 weeks for major strengthening works to be carried out. The obstruction is going to be on a section just the Abermule side of the turn up to Llanmerewig. Access to properties on Abermule side of the obstruction and to 'Captains pitch' will be ok. This closure will cause significant disruption to those who need to travel out of the area via Kerry and of course to the residents of Llanmerewig. Alternative routes will be signposted.
- 2. Proposed Planning application on land adjacent to Kerry Road, by Dolafon Trust. During the next couple of months the Dolafon Trust will be consulting locally on a proposed development scheme for the land adjacent to the Rectory on Kerry Road, and the proposed application will I understand, be for a development that includes housing (on the allocated housing site contained in the Powys UDP) with an adjacent church and relevant car parking.

Residents will recall that an application by the Dolafon Trust for a large church was refused, following appeal, about 18 months ago. The residential part of the new application is likely to propose the building of two houses and two bungalows all for open market sale. The Church proposals will be much different from the previous failed application and the proposed church in this instance is I understand, to provide a capacity of around 150 people and as a result the car parking area is very much reduced to the previous application. The proposed church is intended to be for worshippers from Abermule and surrounding villages, which will operate in addition to the Newtown facility which will continue to operate for worshippers from Newtown.

The proposed application will also encompass a pavement from the village centre going up the B4368 to the site, with a crossing into the Court Close Housing Estate also significant improvement to the junction of the Cefnycoed road where it joins the B 4368 adjacent to the railway crossing.

Under current planning rules the applicants (Dolafon trust) have to undertake local consultation prior to submitting the application. They will be therefore undertaking this at properties close to the proposed site in and the agents acting for the Dolafon Trust inform me that they also proposing to hold a wider community consultation and that this will take the form of a 'drop in' event held at Abermule Community Centre, where residents can view the plans and discuss with the applicants agents (The Doug Hughes Partnership). Date for this 'drop in' consultation yet to be announced.

3. Transportation of Wind Farm components. The transportation of the components for the Garreg Llwyd (Nr Llanbadarn) wind farm, begin on 12th September. There will be one convoy each day consisting of two large lorries (up to 59 metres in length) and they will make their way from Port at Liverpool, via Wrexham, Welshpool and through Newtown before making their way via the new link road, onto Llandrindod Wells road and into site near Llanbadarn. I do not have time for the convoys coming through but it is anticipated to be around mid-day, and there will be deliveries 6 days per week until December. They will use the special passing bays to pull in, so that traffic flow is not unduly affected, including the one at Abermule.


