Update from your County Councillor.

- **1. Powys County Council Budget.** The budget for 2017-20 was approved on 23rd February by the Full Council. The main points are:-
 - Council Tax increase for 2017/18 will be 3.90%
 - The Council has a balanced budget for 2017/18 & 2018/19 but has a deficit for 2019/20 of £6.8million.
 - The budget included £6m for Schools(over 3 years) £7m for ASC(inc.£1.1m to keep Day Centres running) and £500k for Household Waste Recycling Centres to keep all 5 sites in Powys open for at least another year.
 - Council efficiency savings for 3 years 17/19 therefore at £25million.
- 2. Abermule Business Park update. Now that agreement has been reached with WG and the County Council has agreed to purchase the site, completion of transfer is set for April 1st. I have previously advised residents of the interest in the site from the Councils Highways Transport & Recycling Service, and at time of writing this update a report is going to the Cabinet Meeting on Tuesday 28th February with a firm proposal for a recycling unit to be colocated on the site along with the planned development of 10 business units. I will update residents further in next month's NL.
- 3. Planning application for Church on Kerry Road.
 - This application is now in and was registered on 7th November, and details can be found on the Councils Planning website using Planning Application No. P/2017/0134. For those wishing to comment on the application this can be done via the website or by writing to the Planning Officer Tamsin Law at PCC, Planning Department.
- 4. County Council Elections May 2017. As the Portfolio Holder responsible for the Councils Finances, I successfully took the budget through Full Council Meeting on 23rd February and immediately followed up with an announcement that I intend to leave the Council in May after nearly 14 years. Locally this is hardly the best kept secret but I have not been able to formally announce this previously as it was important to protect the integrity of the Councils budget process. Since 2006 when I was first appointed to the Councils Executive it has been a 7 day a week commitment for me with a huge workload at Council as well my commitment to my work in the Dolforwyn Ward. For the sake of my health and in fairness, the need to send more time with Diane and our 6 lovely grandchildren(spread between London & Melbourne!) who currently we hardly ever get to see, I have therefore decided the time is right for me to retire from the County Council. I are delighted that already an ideal candidate has come forward, and a person who already works very hard at the heart of our community.
- 5. DOG MESS!!!! My inbox has been busy with complaints from residents of Dog Mess at various locations in the Community including the <u>School and Community Sports field</u> where <u>NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED.</u> To leave Dog Mess is an offence punishable with a heavy fine. Can I ask residents who see this happen to take a short video of the incident and forward it....the Council will prosecute if it has the evidence. To the minority who commit this unsocial act, I ask you to please act more responsibly and CLEAR UP YOUR DOGS MESS.
