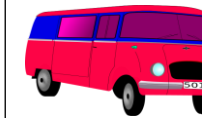

## **UPDATE FROM YOUR COUNTY COUNCILLOR**

**Litter on Highways.** This is a matter that has been the subject of several emails residents noticing/concerned about the amount of litter along our trunk roads. The reason for this is that trunk roads are the responsibility of Welsh Government (WG) and Powys CC is a regular contractor, and one of the functions was to regularly pick litter along trunk roads. In order to cut costs, WG have changed this arrangement and will now only pay to have litter collected prior to grass cutting. Therefore as grass cutting does not take place over winter we have seen a 'build up' of litter become evident. It will be picked therefore prior to grass cutting in May and then prior to each cut through to October. This does not seem at all sensible to me, as the 'first pick' in May will be very time consuming due to quantity and this will mean that Powys CC will be charging WG accordingly.

**Schools Transformation Agenda.** This continues to move forward, although most of activity is concentrated in the South of Powys where we are currently consulting on the closure of three primary schools ( Llanbister, Nantmel & Dolau) and also on the closure of 4 Secondary Schools ( Llandrindod, Builth, Gwernyfed & Brecon) with a proposal to build two new High Schools ( Brecon and Llandrindod/Builth). At present Llandrindod, Builth Wells and Brecon HS have been placed in special measures by Estyn Inspectorate, so urgent action is needed. In Welshpool we are closing all the current Primary Schools and building two new schools, one for teaching in English and one through the medium of Welsh. Progress on the Secondary Schools Transformation in North Powys has been delayed due to demand on resources to cope with current ongoing programme, but a report to Cabinet in September or October will take forward the transformation agenda in North Powys.

**Wind Farm developments.** I provided information in the April newsletter about the changes to the process for wind farm developers which would almost certainly see more applications coming forward. In the meantime, two developers who do have their permission and who have begun building, that is Tirgwnt and Garreg Llwyd. Both will be bringing their wind farm components on a route into Mid Wales via Llanymynech, but for the Tirgwnt development they will go through Welshpool Town and up Golfa, before turning onto the Cwm Golfa approach to Llanfair and then a new link road onto Cefn Coch Road. For Garreg Llwyd development (near Llanbadarn) traffic will follow trunk road to Newtown and then follow a new link road at Mochdre up to trunk road A 483 (Newtown to Llandrindod) before proceeded onto site near Llanbadarn. The Tirgwnt traffic will start late July and complete in September and the Garreg Llwyd transportation will begin in September and complete in December. There will be considerable disruption on these routes during transportation, but there is also current disruption due to highways works being done in preparation.
