Whilst the majority of people exercising their dogs in the vicinities of Abermule and Llandyssil are doing so responsibly, it is coming increasingly to the attention of your Community Council that a few individuals are failing to clean up their own dog's excrement. Our UK Law states that it is an offence to let any dog in your control foul on 'designated land', if you don't clean it up immediately afterwards. To report an incidence of dog fouling not subsequently cleaned-up, members of the public are encouraged to contact Powys County Council by any of the communications media below:

**On-line:** [www.powys.gov.uk/en/public-protection/report-dog-fouling](http://www.powys.gov.uk/en/public-protection/report-dog-fouling) You will need to provide some relevant details: observer's name, residential address and his/her contact (phone / e-mail) details; the location, time and date of the fouling incidence, including the name of the person responsible for the dog at the time (if known), and the name and address of the dog-owner (if known). It is legally permissible for any member of the public to take photographic evidence of an incidence of dog fouling that is not immediately cleaned-up by the respective dog walker / owner; and the observer is encouraged to submit such photographic evidence to Powys CC. With the vigilance and help of all our residents, we can aim to keep the public spaces of our villages and communities tidy, clean and safe, for the benefit of ourselves and our visitors - including in particular our children and elderly folk.

**Next Scheduled Monthly Meetings** all 7.00pm on Wednesday evenings at Llandyssil Old School Hall on 1st August, 5th September and 3rd October 2018. Observers are welcomed to attend. A ten minutes period is allowed at the start of each meeting for public participation. Minutes, agendas and relevant information are accessible on village notice boards and the Council's website. 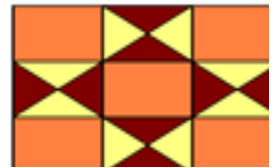
