AERMULE WITH LLANDYSSIL COMMUNITY COUNCIL :

Abermule Business Park Project: It was encouraging to see so many residents attending the all-day 'drop-in' consultation event at the Abermule Community Centre on Thursday 17th May, to meet both Powys County Council and Asbri Planning (the development applicant) officers, who were there on hand to talk informally to individual members of the public. The officers were kept busy during most of the day, explaining all their displayed plans and associated documentation which were exhibited, in connection with the recent proposals to develop the allocated business park on the southern end of Abermule. The evening's more formal Question and Answer forum offered the opportunity for local people to ask further questions and to express their various concerns. The envisaged scheme, currently at its pre-planning phase, proposes a dual function for the site; which is to provide a small number of private commercial units and to locate a third Powys CC Recycling Bulking Facility site (the other two sites having been already built and fully operational at Brecon and Rhayader) to process kerb-side collected recyclable waste materials and prepare the variously sorted items for being transported away from the area for their destined industrial processing. Your Community Council has also formally responded to the same pre-planning consultation process, by requesting answers to a range of 'material' planning matters.

Welsh Government's National 'Getting Involved' Day: On 24th May the community centres at both Llandyssil and Abermule were manned by members of your Council, on behalf of an Independent Review Panel set up by the Welsh Assembly, to welcome and talk one-to-one to the area's inhabitants. This 'pop-in' event was organised at a national level throughout the whole of Wales, to gather the voting public's views and opinions on the present and future role of their Community and Town Councils. Though the turn-out was disappointing, your Council was able to report to the Welsh Government on the expressed perceptions and aspirations of the few that did attend this important event.

Next Scheduled Monthly Meetings (all at 7.00pm on Wednesday evenings at Llandyssil Old School): 6th June, 4th July, 1st Aug, 5th Sept and 3rd Oct 2018. Observers are welcomed to attend; and a ten minute period is allowed at the start of each meeting for public participation. Minutes, agendas and relevant information are all available on both village notice boards and the Council's website. Current planning applications may be viewed on the Powys County Council's 'Planning Portal'.

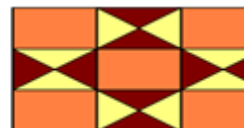
