We must now take this to County Hall Llandrindod Wells on October 18th and show the Powys County Council that we detest and reject the way this matter has been dealt with by Asbri Planning Cardiff and Powys Planning Authority. As our local MP said Cllr Rosemarie Harris-Leader, Powys County Hall, Spa Road East, Llandrindod Wells, Powys, LD1 5LG – is where we need to be sending our letters to. We must put pressure on her to realise the mistake PCC are making by siting such a development on a business park here in Abermule.

I note a lot of comments on A.C.T Facebook page, I urge you all to think carefully about the wording of comments etc to keep the credibility of this form of communication. There is a full council meeting on 18th October at Llandrindod Wells where Jane Rees Vice Chair of Community Council will be asking a question to full council and A.C.T will be organizing transport and hoping to have a big public turnout to show their support against this development.

I am pleased to confirm that our local MP Glyn Davies and AM Russell George are fully behind the Abermule community regarding this development.

GP out of hours services will still be provided by Shropdoc for most of Powys. 111 is being rolled out across Wales and used in England.

Depending on the urgency and severity of your call, you may speak to a health care professional, a nurse, pharmacist or a doctor. If your need is urgent and requires you to see a GP out-of-hours, you will be asked to attend a primary care centre at one of our hospital sites. NHS 111 call takers are trained to recognise when there is a threat to life; if you need an ambulance, you will be put through to the emergency ambulance service.
