- 1/. PCC told us that they will seriously look at our proposed alternative construction site and ask planning to review the LDP restrictions on this sit and if favourable consult Trunk Road Agency, with the view to constructing the RFB there and not in Abermule.
- 2/. If it proves impossible to move the RFB plant from Abermule, the engineering department have conceded that they will look at all ways they can reduce the size, or reposition the building on the site as well as providing additional suitable screening.
- 3/. We also asked for compensation for the Abermule community if this RFB plant goes ahead. Your suggestions are invited.
