A special nativity story trail will be illuminated at St Nicholas' Church as part of the Christmas Festival lights.

This features ten specially-designed, transparent, stained glass coloured, recycled bottle depictions of scenes from the Nativity story.

Each scene was created by local artist Josette Gresty and MEG's David Wilson. The lights will use eco-generated power from a small water-wheel based in the Whitegates Pool wildlife area, stored in batteries and used to illuminate several parts of the town's Christmas
