**PLEASE BE RESPONSIBLE FOR WASTE AND KEEP YOUR VILLAGE TIDY :** The Community Council employ a Contractor to collect from the Dog waste bins around the village. The waste is then collected by Powys County Council from the **TWO LARGE GREEN WHEELIE BINS PROVIDED FOR THIS PURPOSE ONLY.** It has also been brought to our attention that food waste bags have been left in the bus shelter. Powys County Council collect food waste, plastic, tins, paper, glass on a weekly basis and black wheelie bins on a three weekly cycle from residents, there is no excuse for anyone to dump their rubbish elsewhere in the village.
