

HELP NEEDED TO TRACE FAMILIES OF LOCAL WW1 HEROES

Llanmerewig Church, is seeking help in tracing the families and friends of two local men who served in WW1, but were somehow overlooked in the past; perhaps you may know someone who has memories of them. As a result of research undertaken for the centenary of WW1, it was noted that although there are three Commonwealth War Graves in Llanmerewig Churchyard, only the name of one of these men is listed on the War Memorial inside the church.

With a grant from the Powys War Memorials Project we are adding an additional Memorial Plaque with the names of **Thomas Clement Evans** and

John Albert Edward Parry.

ABERMULE with LLANDYSSIL COMMUNITY COUNCIL:

LOCAL DEMOCRACY UNDER THREAT AGAIN: New proposals for large wind and solar farm 'Priority Areas' in Powys are identified by the Welsh Assembly Government National Development Framework. This will over-ride local planning with applications determined by the Welsh Government. Priority Areas cover one quarter of Powys outside the Brecon Beacons. The Areas carry a presumption in favour of development and will, of course, require extensive transmission infrastructure as there is no current Grid capacity. Powys is to be subsumed into a Swansea / Llanelli City Region and subject to their Strategic Development Plan. This is all so undemocratic even our AM, Russell George, knew nothing of the proposals. 


