ABERMULE with LLANDYSSIL COMMUNITY COUNCIL:

RAILWAY MEMORIAL. The railway memorial donated by Network Rail to mark the centenary of the Abermule rail crash has been mounted on a stone adjacent to the path that runs behind the football dugout at the community centre. The council will discuss the placement of a bench next to the memorial at the next meeting.
