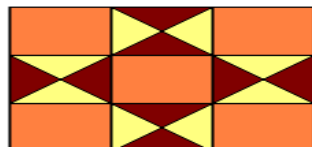

## MONTGOMERYSHIRE WILDLIFE TRUST

Montgomeryshire Wildlife Trust love all wildlife, but we do have a soft spot for fungi! This time of year is a great opportunity to get out and look for fungi, particularly waxcap grassland fungi. This fungi group are characterised by colourful waxcaps, but also include other species like coral fungi and earthtongues. They are often found in low nutrient areas of pasture, meadows and grasslands. They can even be found on your garden lawn if the conditions are right! Plant life have a survey called Waxcap Watch which you can take part in to help them identify good waxcap grasslands.
