

ABERMULE with LLANDYSSIL COMMUNITY COUNCIL:

BULK RECYCLING FACILITY NRW have issued the permit to allow PCC to operate this facility. However, it is noted that PCC do not have planning consent to handle municipal waste and should they choose to do so in the future, they must take odour measurements to show that the figures submitted in the application are realistic.

<u>PLAY AREAS</u> It is with much regret, the council have had to close the play area on Felin Hafren due to the equipment deteriorating to such an extent that it is no longer safe to use. The installation of play equipment is very expensive, but the council will be looking at how they can reopen the area as soon as possible. Some work has been done in the play area by the school, including the filling in of a hole on the earth mound. Can parents of children who like digging holes, please stop them from doing so in the play areas as it becomes dangerous for other users.
